BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA

WHEREAS, Douglas County has a signed agreement with the Metropolitan Utilities District (M.U.D.) to purchase M.U.D.'s property, located directly to the south of the Douglas County Courthouse, and the County will subsequently sell that real estate to the Omaha-Douglas Public Building Commission (ODPBC); and,

WHEREAS, this Board desires that the ODPBC, once it takes ownership of that real estate, issue \$114 million in revenue bonds to fund the construction of a justice center and youth detention center on the site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, that this Board hereby requests that the Omaha-Douglas Public Building Commission issue revenue bonds in the amount of \$114 million to fund the construction of a justice center and youth detention center on the former M.U.D. site located directly to the south of the Douglas County Courthouse.
