Omaha, NE - The Douglas County Clerk/Comptroller's Office will be changing office hours beginning in 2019.

Today, Douglas County Clerk/Comptroller Daniel Esch said beginning January 2, 2019, the Douglas County Clerk/Comptroller's Office will be open 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday (excluding holidays).

Esch also said that starting in January 2019, the office will be open by appointment only for marriage license applicants until 6:00 PM on the first Thursday of each month.

"The staff in the County Clerk/Comptroller's Office appreciates the privilege of issuing marriage licenses to couples. It's an honor to be a part of such an important moment in their lives," Esch said.

Esch said for the remainder of 2018, the Douglas County Clerk/Comptroller's office hours will remain 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday (excluding holidays).

The Douglas County Clerk/Comptroller's Office issues approximately 4,000 marriage licenses annually. Instructions and forms can be found at www.douglascountyclerk.org/marriage-licenses.

Other duties of the Douglas County Clerk/Comptroller's Office include issuing locksmith licenses, issuing certain liquor and tobacco licenses, recording military discharge papers, maintaining Douglas County financial accounting records, auditing all payments made by Douglas County, processing payroll for Douglas County employees, and serving as the official record keeper of the Douglas County Board.
