

Criminal Justice Committee Meeting

Tuesday, July 10, 2018

The Criminal Justice Committee convened on Tuesday, July 10, 2018, at 2:51 p.m. and was called to order by Commissioner Boyle in Room 903 of the Omaha-Douglas Civic Center, 1819 Farnam Street, Omaha, NE 68183.
